

# Carrington News: July 2023

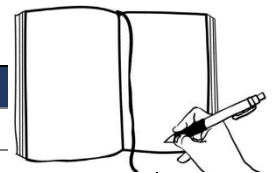

## Uniform

As we approach the end of the academic year, I wanted to remind you all about school uniform expectations for September.

The Carrington uniform is:

- Navy blue or grey jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt.
- Grey trousers, skirts or pinafore dresses.
- Blue, white or grey shirt, blouse or polo shirt.
- Navy or grey shorts or blue gingham dresses (for early Autumn/Summer)
- Shoes should be black, sensible and practical; no trainers.
- Navy blue book bag (which can be purchased from the office for £6).



## PE Kit:

- White, pale blue or navy-blue T-Shirt
- Navy or black shorts or jogging bottoms
- In colder weather, a navy, grey or
- Plimsolls or trainers
- PE kit should be brought to school to change into during the school day
